

Nathaniel A. Lynd is an assistant professor of chemical engineering at the University of Texas at Austin. He graduated from the University of Minnesota with a Ph. D. in Materials Chemistry in the group of Marc Hillmyer. Following graduation, he moved to the Materials Research Laboratory at the University of California–Santa Barbara where he carried out work in areas of polymer science encompassing a broad range of synthetic, physical, and theoretical topics. He joined Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory in August 2013 as a staff scientist before moving to UT-Austin in 2015.
